- The Memorial race has been moved to Saturday November 20th
 - It's a day race
 - Gates are scheduled to open at 7am
 - Track will go hot at 9am
 - There will be a drivers meeting and a memorial service in the grandstands following the last qualifying pass. Please listen to the loud speakers.
- We have a schedule for the 2022 season.
 - We have 14 scheduled races
 - 11 races will be in Tucson
 - 3 races will be at WHP
 - 12 of the 14 races will be weekend races, shared with other clubs, no team events.
 - Only 2 races will be at night
 - 10 of the races will be completed by April 30th
 - I have sponsorship commitments for half of the races. Need commitments for all 14 races or there will be possible cancellations
 - I am sending out an email tomorrow to all racers and possible sponsors asking for additional help to complete the season
 - We're thinking that we will lose 4 races due to weather and big ticket conflicts. That will give us 10 races.
 - If any race is canceled, we will:
 - Transfer the funds to the Memorial or,
 - Refund the funds to the sponsor
 - If no race cancels; then we'll have the biggest season ever!
 - Change of 40 points, from 30 points
 - The Memorial race is scheduled for November 12th in Tucson
 - The first races are scheduled for January 8th and 9th in Tucson
